

When Jim English opened his station in 1962, it was considered west of the village of Waterdown. Jim had served in the Merchant Navy and the US Merchant Marines during the war.

Later on the location became a used car lot before being bought and developed by Flamboro Center Properties in 1983. Named "Hawksview" after a nearby residential development, a commercial plaza grew around the original station. What is currently the unit occupied by Waterdown Income Tax and Bookkeeping was previously two units. Adjacent to the dental office was the community police station and next to it was a barber shop. What was once fields surrounding the location is now commercial and residential developments.
